

INFORMATION REGARDING DILATING EYE DROPS

Dilating drops are used to dilate or enlarge the pupils of the eye to allow the ophthalmologist to get a better view of the inside of your eye.

Dilating drops frequently blur vision for a length of time which varies from person to person and may make bright lights bothersome. It is not possible for your ophthalmologist to predict how much your vision will be affected.

Most patients are able to drive themselves after being dilated and having sunglasses will help. If needed we can also provide you with a pair of disposable sunglasses. However if you live faraway and the weather is bad please consider having a driver accompany you to your appointment.
